1. What features of being a part of a family are most important to you?

#### **DIGGING DEEPER**

- 2. Read 1 Tim 5:1-2.
  Differentiate between the 4 family member roles by which Timothy was to model his church interaction. How is this counter-cultural?
- 3. Do a quick search of "widow" in the Old Testament. What stands out to you?
- 4. Read John 19:26-27. What stands out from Jesus' example?
- 5. Read 5:3-8. The church offered support to widows of all ages. What criteria were required to receive church support?
- 6. Read 5:9-10. What differentiated the widows who were on "the list?"

- 7. What 3 criteria were necessary to qualify for "the list?"
- 8. Why did Paul refuse to place younger widows on "the list?" (vv.11-15)

#### LIVING IT OUT

- 9. How might the example of the women on "the list" challenge views Christians have of retirement?
- 10. How can believers care for their aging parents?
- 11. The Greek word "widow" doesn't speak of how a woman was left alone. What other situations might leave women alone or vulnerable? What is the church's responsibility to them? What is yours?
- 12. Why did Paul require widows receiving support to pursue godliness? Should that limit church support today? How?
