1. What emotions have you or others you know experienced from the Coronavirus crisis? How have you dealt with them?

DIGGING DEEPER

2. Read 1 Tim 6:20-21. Paul began by saying "O, Timothy!" What is your favorite expression to say when you're excited?
3. Refer to Galatians 1:8-9. What does Paul think of those who corrupt the Gospel?
4. Describe how Paul guarded the Gospel in Galatians 2:11-21.
5. How does Paul describe false teaching in 1 Timothy 6:20b?
6. Read Acts 17:11 and describe how to test truth.
7. Describe the danger of false teaching using 1 Corinthians 5:6.

8. Paul concludes with "grace to all." Why is God's grace so important in living the Christian life?

9. On a scale of 0-10, how excited are you about the Gospel? When was it higher? How could it be greater?
10. What are practical ways you can guard the gospel?
11. In what ways have you seen or experienced false teaching?
