- 2. Read 1 Tim 6:20-21. Paul began by saying "0, Timothy!" What is your favorite expression to say when you're excited?
- 3. Refer to Galatians 1:8-9. What does Paul think of those who corrupt the Gospel?
- 4. Describe how Paul guarded the Gospel in Galatians 2:11-21.
- 5. How does Paul describe false teaching in 1 Timothy 6:20b?
- 6. Read Acts 17:11 and describe how to test truth.
- 7. Describe the danger of false teaching using 1 Corinthians 5:6.

8. Paul concludes with "grace to all." Why is God's grace so important in living the Christian life?
