2. Would you call yourself one? Why or why not?

3. Read 1 Tim 6:11-13. Why is the person of God known for what they flee?
4. Read 1Cor 10:13. What promises does God make for those who want to flee?
5. Read or summarize Gen 39 about Joseph's experience as a "man of God" in Potiphar's house. What lessons are there about fleeing sin?
6. Take turns describing each of the 6 character traits of a person of God in v. 11. How would you summarize the entire list?
7. Read about the armor of God in Eph 6:10-18. What weapons does a Christian use to "fight?"

8. How would you describe the ways Jesus "fought the good fight?" Discuss his tactics toward unbelievers, Pharisees, Satan, and Pilate.
9. Name and define the attributes of God Paul describes to motivate Timothy in v.13-16.

10. Practically speaking, how does a Christian "flee" sin?
11. What are some of the major attacks on "the faith" today?
12. Its been said, "You can only manage what you can measure." How might you measure your progress in the 6 character traits of v.11?
